RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered a proposal for the installation of *Questions Worth Having Answers To* by Kameelah Janan Rasheed, Abolitionist Place (formerly Willoughby Square Park), Willoughby Street, Abolitionist Place (Duffield Street) and Gold Street, Brooklyn, submitted by the Department of Cultural Affairs' Percent for Art Program and the Economic Development Corporation, represented by exhibits 5587-JF, JG, JH & JX of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous conceptual approval with the understanding that the artist will undertake a community engagement process to develop the content of the artwork and the preliminary submission will include the results of this feedback in addition to the design of the freestanding element. Commissioner Aarons and Commissioner Armstead recused themselves.
